

# The HOMELOST Project

## HOW TO SEW THE SQUARES TOGETHER INTO QUILT FRONTS

- The squares have been pre-pinned together into columns of six squares each. You will need four columns (24 squares total) to make one quilt.
- Complete sewing one column at a time.
- Sew the squares together leaving a  $\frac{1}{2}$  seam on each connection.
- Once all four columns are sewn, pin the columns together.
- Sew one column to the next leaving a  $\frac{1}{2}$  seam on each connection.
- Once all the squares are sewn together into the quilt front the fleece backing can be added.
